
Motivate(her) strives to make a meaningful impact on the community by:

Where Will Your Funding Go?

As we launch our podcast and begin interviewing female leaders to share their stories with the world, we require funding to elevate the quality and reach of our content. Your generous support will be allocated across the following areas:

Marketing

We will be interviewing four female leaders for the 2021-2022 academic year. Each interview will produce two 30-minute podcast episodes, for a total of eight episodes. To have our podcast reach as many listeners as possible, we will need to market each episode. We plan to leverage the University of Calgary network and paid ads on social media (e.g. Facebook, Spotify, Instagram) to attract a wide audience.

Website

We have a designated volunteer website coordinator to oversee the development and design of our website. However, we still require funds to support the website domain (www.motivateher.ca) and web hosting for the podcast.

Equipment

Currently, the Motivate(her) team will be renting audio equipment directly from the University of Calgary to record our interviews. For long-term operations, we would like to invest in high-quality audio, video, and editing equipment that can be used to support the Motivate(her) podcast for years to come.
